

Letter to Teacher Assignment

Although Mrs. Lievers will take many opportunities to talk with you, she would like to know more about you as this school year begins. Please take this assignment seriously so that we can have a successful year!

This letter must be typed and in letter format. This assignment is worth 20 points.

The requirements of the letter are as follows:

- The date
- A greeting for the reader (i.e. "Dear Mrs....")
- Introduce yourself and write about your likes/dislikes, hobbies, etc.
- Tell why math is important to you; you cannot say it is not!
- Explain what struggles you have had in math or what areas you need to work on
- How do you think that you, with the help of your teacher(s), can overcome these struggles?
- Explain what areas of math that you are good at, what are your strengths?
- Anything else that you'd like your teacher(s) to know!
- A closing to the letter (i.e. "Sincerely...")

Leaving out *any information* will result in a deduction of points.
